Scope and Contents

Philip C. Wakeley of the Southern Forest Experiment Station of the U.S. Forest Service led the research effort to develop reforestation procedures. In 1934, Wakeley moved his research program to the Kisatchie National Forest's Stuart Nursery to take advantage of CCC resources. His career covered 40 years, all with the Southern Forest Experiment Station in New Orleans. He was recognized by a number of awards: USDA Superior Service Award, and elected by Society of American Foresters as Fellow and for the Barrington Moore Award for Biological Research.

Red River & Gulf Railroad (mix)

The RR&G was incorporated in Louisiana on April 21, 1905, for the purpose of acquiring and operating a railroad extending from Lecompte. Its parents were the Crowell & Spencer Lumber Company log tram and the stockholders of the Crowell & Spencer Lumber Company. The last train ran on March 30, 1954 and the rails were removed by that May. The RR&G was gone except for the segment between Long Leaf Jct. and Long Leaf, which was sold to Crowell Long Leaf Lumber to serve the mill and is still in place today at SFHM.

World War II brought to Louisiana the construction of new military facilities and the expansion of existing ones such as Camps Beauregard, Livingston, Claiborne and (now Fort) Polk. These camps and others throughout the state trained soldiers in the Louisiana Maneuvers and brought construction jobs to Louisiana.
